Dave has worked as a collection manager at the Natural History Museum of Denmark and has experience teaching numerous entomology courses including, the University of Guelph, University of Copenhagen, Ontario Universities Program in Field Biology and Niagara College. Dave is now focused on building DKB Digital Designs which is dedicated to developing educational software such as Bugdex and BugFinder.

**Jen Llewellyn** is the Provincial Nursery and Landscape Specialist with OMAFRA and has been for over 18 years. She holds a B.Sc. and M.Sc. in Horticulture from the University of Guelph and is also a Certified Arborist.
