

# Vehicle First Aid Box Requirements & Inspection Record

Every employer using a vehicle to transport workers shall equip the vehicle with a first aid box.

Employers shall inspect first aid boxes and their contents at not less than quarterly-yearly intervals and shall mark the inspection card for each box with the date of the most recent inspection and the signature of the person making the inspection.\*
