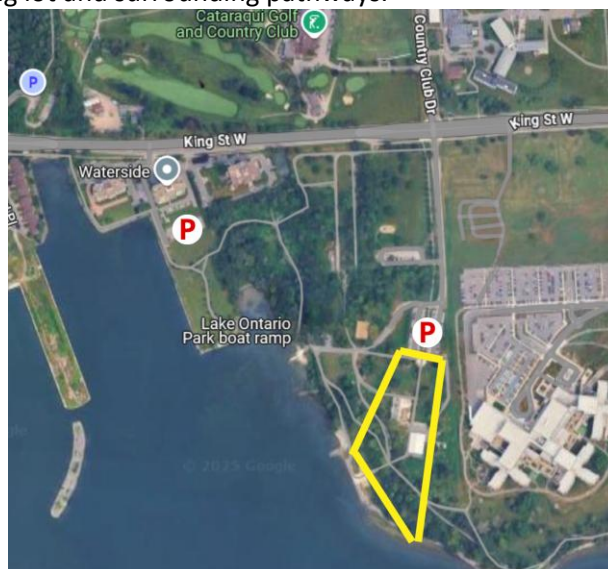
*We will provide a rough tradeshow area map in September (we may ask large equipment move in at 6:00AM and others to move in at 6:30 AM)

Exhibitor Booths

- Exhibitor space is approximate 10' x 10' (or larger: we will have space for equipment).
- If you're bringing equipment, just ensure you've received ISAO approval in advance.
- Note for equipment over 4500 kgs, you must park equipment on your own mats.
- Note equipment can be a static display only.
- Please bring your own table, chairs, tent, etc.
- If there's light rain we'll be going ahead with the event. If there's a thunderstorm, lightning, etc. we'll pause or stop the event. If needed Sunday Sept 21 will be our rain day.

Meals for Exhibitors

- Exhibitors will be provided with a lunch sandwich on Friday and Saturday.
- Morning coffee will be available on Friday and Saturday. Water, drinks and snacks will also be available throughout the day.
- Washrooms are available in the park.

General Conduct

- The OTCC is an opportunity to showcase the professionalism of the industry to the public. All attendees must refrain from alcohol consumption and/or legal or illegal drug use immediately prior to, during, and after the competition, including while on competition/park grounds.
- Participants are expected to abide by the park and municipal regulations.
