OTCC Schedule

The OTCC is a two-day event Friday Sept 11 and Saturday Sept 12.

We will be using a similar schedule as last year so climbers will have breaks throughout both days.

The OTCC will be held in [Niagara Parks Botanical Gardens: 2565 Niagara River Pkwy, Niagara Falls, ON L2E 2S7](#)

We'll email a trade show area map and instructions for vendor access in September.

The outdoor trade show will be located on the grass in the competition area.

We will be placing mats down along the pathway in the competition area for entry and exit.

Exhibitor move-in: Friday 5:00am for trailers / equipment (or later ~6:30am for hand-carrying in items)

Exhibitor move-out: approx. Saturday 5:00pm for trailers/equipment (can be earlier for hand-carrying items)

Security will be on site Friday night.

Exhibitors: Park Access and Equipment

This is a beautiful park with a number of fragile and rare/specimen trees. The pathway leading to our competition area is smaller and narrower than usual. Niagara asked us to limit traffic in the competition area. You can bring trailers and equipment BUT note the following limitations:

- A trailer/flatbed sized 16 ft long and 8 ft wide can fit along the pathway and into the competition/trade show area. But anything larger than that cannot, as the access path is narrow with tight turns.
- You can bring a trailer into the competition/ trade show area but you must detach it & note size limits above.
- We cannot leave cars/pickup trucks parked in the competition/ trade show area.
- For bringing equipment on a flatbed/truck/trailer larger than 16 ft long & 8 ft wide: You will park in the vendor parking lot, unload, and then you will need to move the unit to the competition/ trade show area. The park does not have a forklift to move large items
- To unload items from a vehicle, you would park in the vendor parking lot. You can use hand carts to bring items into the competition area. We will also have gators on site to help during move-in and move-out.
- For move-out: to move vehicles/equipment out of the competition/trade show area on Saturday: we will

direct traffic out at a designated time (around 5:00). You cannot drive out on your own. We will need to set mats on the pathway before any vehicles/ equipment can exit. (You can hand carry items out earlier).

- If you have questions about getting equipment in, just call or email us and we will do what we can to work with you
- Niagara Parks waived their usual parking fee so there will be no fee for vendors to park in the vendor parking lot for the OTCC

Exhibitor Space

- Exhibitor space is approximately 10' x 10' (or larger if bringing approved equipment).
- If you're bringing equipment, you must receive ISA Ontario approval in advance.
- Note for equipment over 4500 kgs, you must park equipment on your own mats.
- Please bring your own table, chairs, tent, etc.
- If there's light rain we'll be going ahead with the event. If there's a thunderstorm, lightning, etc. we'll pause or stop the event. If needed Sunday Sept 13 will be our rain day.

Meals for Exhibitors

- Exhibitors will be provided with a lunch on Friday and Saturday as well as coffee, water, drinks and snacks.
- Washrooms are available in the park. There is also a café with food for purchase.

General Conduct

- The OTCC is an opportunity to showcase the professionalism of the industry to the public. All attendees must refrain from alcohol consumption and/or legal or illegal drug use immediately prior to, during, and after the competition, including while on competition/park grounds.
- Attendees are expected to abide by the park and municipal regulations.
- Any commercial use of images to promote products or services is not permitted unless written consent is received from ISA Ontario, and in some cases the individual in the image.
